Dr. Yi-You Chiou is the Chief of the Division of Abdominal Imaging, Department of Radiology, at Taipei Veterans General Hospital and the Associate Professor at National Yang Ming University School. He is interested in liver imaging, abdominal imaging, radiofrequency ablation for liver neoplasm, and interventional radiology.

He received his M.D. from National Yang Ming University School in 1988, finished his Residency at Taipei Veterans General Hospital in 1996, and became the attending physician at Department of Radiology of Taipei Veterans General Hospital since 1997. He had stayed at Massachusetts General Hospital, Boston, USA, 2001-2002 and completed his training of Radiofrequency Tumor Ablation (RFA) under the guidance of Professor Mueller. After returning to Taiwan, he has performed RFA on more than 3000 hepatocellular carcinoma patients, and on kidney, lung, adrenal cancer patients too. Microwave Therapy and Cryotherapy were also introduced into Taipei Veterans General Hospital by Dr. Chiou since 2010.

He has published many international scientific peer review papers and was the author or coauthor in more than 100 articles in well-known journals.
