Professor Huang was graduated from Kaohsiung Medical University in 1989 and received his Ph.D. from the Graduate Institute of Medicine, Kaohsiung Medical University in 2011.

Professor Huang has dedicated into research of liver diseases for decades. His main research interests include basic and clinical research of viral hepatitis, fatty liver disease, liver cancers and imaging studies. He has also involved in the clinical research of viral hepatitis, fatty liver disease and metabolic abnormalities of liver diseases. He has published many peer-reviewed articles. Currently, he serves as the Associate Editor of Kaohsiung Journal of Medical Science, Academic Editor of PLOS ONE journal, and reviewer of many international journals. He makes his efforts in epidemiological works for viral hepatitis elimination in the endemic and underprivileged areas.
