Ulrike M. Hamper MD, MBA has been the Director of Ultrasound at the Russell H. Morgan Department of Radiology and Professor of Radiology, Urology and Pathology at Johns Hopkins University, Baltimore, Maryland from 1990 to 2016. Dr. Hamper has also been the medical director of the Ultrasound school in the Johns Hopkins Imaging School from 1990-2016. Dr. Hamper holds a Master in Business Administration (M.B.A.) degree from the Johns Hopkins University Carey Business School. Dr. Hamper received her medical degree from the University of Bonn, Germany. She completed a year of a Pathology Residency at the University of Cologne, Germany before starting her Radiology Residency and 2 years of Fellowships at the Johns Hopkins University, School of Medicine.

Dr. Hamper is a nationally and internationally recognized authority in the field of ultrasonography. Dr. Hamper's research activities, clinical and teaching experiences are extensive, covering the entire spectrum of ultrasound and ultrasound guided interventional procedure. Dr. Hamper is the author or co-author of over 220 peer reviewed publications and scientific abstracts in addition to numerous book chapters, 2 books and numerous exhibits at major scientific meetings. She is either the principal investigator or co-investigator on numerous scientific grants. Dr. Hamper has been an invited lecturer and visiting professor both nationally and internationally on numerous occasions. She also serves or has served on the Editorials Boards of *Radiology*, *Journal of Clinical Ultrasound*, and *Journal of Women's Imaging*, *Ultrasound Quarterly* and 2 terms as Associate Editor of *Radiology*.

Dr. Hamper has served national organized radiology societies including the American Institute of Ultrasound in Medicine (AIUM) (Board of Governors, member of multiple AIUM committees), Society of Radiologists in Ultrasound (Secretary, Treasurer, President-Elect, President and Past President), American College of Radiology (Ultrasound commission and multiple committees) the Academy of Radiology Research (Board of Directors) and



American Board of Radiology (Examiner, Item writer for the written examination, Chair of the Oral and Conditioning Examination Committee and member of the Maintenance of Certification (MOC) Core and Certifying Committees. Dr. Hamper is also a member of the Board of Directors of the Joint Review Committee for Education in Diagnostic Medical Sonography (JRCDMS). Dr. Hamper has received numerous honors and awards among them the Distinguished Service Award and the Lifetime Achievement Award from the American Board of Radiology, the Faculty Teaching Award (Johns Hopkins University) and Fellow Trainee Award (Radiological Society of North America). Dr. Hamper has also been recognized by her peers through Fellowship selection in the Society of Radiologists in Ultrasound (FSRU), the American Institute of Ultrasound in Medicine (FAIUM), and the American College of Radiology (FACR).
