Dr. Lin is one of the pioneers in Taiwan who developed techniques in the field of ultrasound-guided peripheral nerve block. He graduated from National Defense Medical Center in Taiwan, and obtained his Anesthesiology training at its teaching hospital. Thereafter he worked at affiliated hospitals of Taipei Medical University, where he gained a doctorate from the Graduate Institute of Clinical Medicine. Dr. Lin's research interests mostly involved regional block. He has a great passion for ultrasound-guided regional techniques, especially in the fields of safety and ergonomics. He has been invited to present lectures and participate as a faculty member and/or instructor for peripheral nerve workshops at scientific meetings. Not only working for the official journal of Taiwan Society of Anesthesiologists as an editor since 2003, he has also been appointed as the lead guest editor for special issues regarding deep regional blocks in *BioMed Research International*. Besides, he has been invited to write textbook chapters in the same field.
