Shi-Ming Lin studied medicine at National Taiwan University and graduated in 1982, Following this, he completed a clinical resident training in Veteran General Hospital Taipei and GI fellowship in Chang-Gung Memorial Hospital-Taipei and Linkuo. Dr. Lin is currently a Professor since 2007 and a deputy chairman at the Department of Gastroenterology and Hepatology, Chang Gung University since 2014.

Dr. Lin is one of the pioneers of RFA for liver tumors in Taiwan. Dr. Lin has published 120 papers in international and domestic scientific journals including Gastroenterology, Hepatology, Gut, Journal of Hepatology, Cancer, and British Journal of Surgery. Dr. Lin has 4 papers (published in Hepatology 1999 and Gastroenterology 2004, Gut 2005 and J Hepato 2007) ranked as the highly cited papers. Dr. Lin has given 110 invited lectures in the area of his expertise on occasions to international audiences including APASL(2006,2008-9,2012,2013), APDW (2007, 09), Annual Microwave Surg Meeting Jpn (2008, 09), Kobe HCC symposium (2009), APPLE (2010-2015), 2013 Korea-Japan Image-guide Tumor Ablation Meeting, Japan JSH 2012, HK IDD 2011, HK Interventional Radiology Symposium 2009, South East Asian Nations conference (2008, 2010, 2012), and Singapore GI Annual Meeting 2009, Asian Congress of Tumor Ablation (ACTA) 2014,2015; 4th International Kyoto Liver Cancer Symposium (IKLS) 2014, Mongolia DDW 2014, The Hepatic Oncology Multi-disciplinary Approach Symposium(TOMAS), Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia 2014, and Taiwan-France HCC symposium 2014. Quarter century's contribution to liver research by TASL 2015, APAITO 2016, ACTA 2016, University of Tokyo 10,000 RFA meeting (Nov 17, 2016). Dr. Lin is serving as a journal referee of many peer-review journals including Gastroenterology, Hepatology, Gut, J Hepatol, Ann Surg, et al. His research interest include diagnosis and treatment of hepatoma and antiviral therapies for hepatitis B and C.
