Prof. Nakamoto is one of pioneers in Japan that developed techniques in the field of ultrasound-guided regional anesthesia (USGRA). He graduated from Osaka city Medical school in 1992, and also earned his medical degree from there in 1996. His professional academic fields are drug metabolism and disposition of local anesthetics and USGRA for lower extremity. He has made efforts to promote the popularization of USGRA in Japan. He is a regular guest speaker and workshop instructor throughout national and international meeting and session of USGRA. He holds positions on the Board member of the Japanese Society of Regional Anesthesia, and has great interests in regional anesthesia, pain medicine, and rehabilitation of orthopedic surgery. He has some scientific papers related to the local anesthetics and USGRA by peer-reviewed journal. He also wrote some part of the textbook of USGRA in Japanese and English.
