At the same time, I spent 6 months in Adelaide Australia on a HMDP fellowship to gain experience in O&G imaging in 1991. It was during the fellowship that I also received training in reading mammograms. I headed the department from 1990-2003, and again from 2010-2013.

When I completed my headship in 2013, the Department of Diagnostic and Interventional Imaging had a total of 18 ultrasound units in the main department, 2 MRI scanners, a CT, and CT cum gamma camera. In addition, at the Breast centre, the Department also manages a breast imaging unit with 3 mammography units and 4 ultrasound units is located in the Breast Centre. I continue to spend sessions in the Antenatal Diagnostic Centre on obstetric ultrasound.
