Professor Disya Ratanakorn received her Medical Degree from Faculty of Medicine Siriraj Hospital, Mahidol University, Bangkok, Thailand. She then received her training in neurology at Faculty of Medicine Ramathibodi Hospital, Mahidol University and the Institute of Neurology and Neurosurgery, Queen Square, London, UK. She trained in transcranial Doppler ultrasonography at University of Bonn, Germany and was a Fellow in Stroke and Neurosonology at Department of Neurology, Wake Forest University School of Medicine, North Carolina, USA.

She has published several articles in neurology especially in stroke and neurosonology. She was elected as a Fellow member of the American Institute of Ultrasound in Medicine in 2001, a Fellow member of the American Academy of Neurology in 2002, and an Honorary member of the Korea Society of Neurosonology in 2010.

She has been served as a member of Executive Board of the Neurosonology Research Group of the World Federation of Neurology (NSRG-WFN) in 2001-2005 and 2005-2009, a member of International Relations Committee and Neurosonology Examination Committee of the American Society of Neuroimaging in 2003-2005, a member of International Commission of International Certification for Neurosonology of NSRG-WFN 2005-2009, and a member of Board of Directors of the World Stroke Organization in 2012-2016.

She was appointed as Professor of Neurology at Faculty of Medicine Ramathibodi Hospital, Mahidol University, Thailand in 2003. She has been elected as the President of Thai Stroke Society in 2010-2012 and 2012-2014.

She has been appointed as International Lecturer in Neurosonology at Department of Neurology, Wake Forest University School of Medicine, Winston-Salem, North Carolina, USA since 2000 until present, Visiting Professor in Neurosonology at Kaiser Permanente Medical Center, Orange County, California, USA in 2001, Visiting Professor in Neurosonology at King / Drew Medical Center, Charles R. Drew University, Los Angeles, California, USA in 2001, and Visiting Professor at Division of Neurology, Department of Medicine & Therapeutics, Prince of Wales Hospital Faculty of Medicine , The Chinese University of Hong Kong, Hong Kong since 2006 until present.
